Duane Davidson, elected as Washington State Treasurer in 2016, joined the Washington State Investment Board (WSIB) as an ex-officio member in January 2017. Previously, Davidson served as Benton County Treasurer, where he was initially elected in 2003 and was subsequently re-elected in 2014 to his fourth term.

Davidson, a certified public accountant, is serving his second term as President for the Washington State Association of County Treasurers (WSACT) and previously served as treasurer for the organization. He has served on WSACT's Audit, Legislative and Website committees and has acted as the organization's historian/archivist.

Prior to elected office, Davidson served as the Chief Financial Accountant for Benton County. He also worked as an auditor for the Washington State Auditor's Office where he worked as the Assistant Audit Manager in the Tri-Cities and was responsible for the Walla Walla regional offices.

He is past-president for two separate Kiwanis Clubs in the Tri-Cities, currently serving as treasurer for the Kiwanis Club of Tri Cities Industry Foundation. He also has served as a church speaker for Gideon International and as church treasurer.

Davidson was born and raised in Carnation, WA. He graduated from Tolt High School, began undergraduate education at Bellevue Community College and, after transferring to Central Washington University, received a bachelor's degree in accounting.
